Comfort Control

The Comfort Control manages the electric or 'boost' heating.

This new generation control method is based on having enough hot water. Turn the control up for more guaranteed hot water reserved, down for less.

Using advanced computer logic to determine a range of settings, you only have to tell the controller what your expectations are for your reserved hot water and savings with a single dial. It takes care of the rest.

At first it might be best to start with a maximum or high setting and gradually reduce over some time (maybe days) until the best balance is found.

Comfort set to 0% = Holiday mode and the tank will not heat with the electric elements except if BioSafe sterilisation is required.

Hot Water Level Gauge

This is an estimation of useful hot water stored in your tank. Senztek uses techniques to keep this as accurate as possible. Most of the time the accuracy will be good, sometimes precise especially if the tank is heating.

Tariff Tables

The Tariff Tables reside in the controller and are selected (usually at installation) to minimise the home owners electricity cost by matching the households hot water use profile and expectations to 4 different time bands for each day. Therefore just heating the hot water you need.

These tables are discussed in the 'Smart' controller user guide.
